It has been found that the first 40 to 60 35650Bs will experience power supply tripping when a 35659A, option AMV or HO1, SCSI module is installed.

When the 35659A disc drive motor starts, it causes noise to couple onto the +5V Reference. Noise on the +5V ref causes the +5 under-voltage comparator to erroneously trip and toggle the system PRST line.

The 35650-66511 board was modified to eliminate this problem.
