#### **Solution/Action:**

Replace the CPU board assembly (HP P/N 04155-69541). Service parts are already modified version but the part number is the same.

To check if a CPU board assembly is a modified version, find the EDC (engineering date code) and MDC (manufacturing date code) label. The EDC of modified version is 3808 or greater.

Perform this service note in "Agreeable Time" category for the above serial number bands even if the above symptom is not observed, and also for units that have an EDC earlier than 3808 (typically previously repaired units using "bad" service parts).
