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Solution/Action:

Install a 1 megohm bleed resistor (R300) between the AC and ACC line input terminals on the A1 printed circuit board. This puts the resistor in parallel with C131.

R300 is installed on the bottom of the main PC board at the input connector J4. Center the tubing on the resistor and bend the resistor leads 90 degrees at the ends of the tubing. Remove the solder from J4 outside terminals and wrap the resistor leads around the J4 pins and resolder. Insure the resistor body is flat against the PC board for maximum clearance to the chassis.
