Situation:

The A14 Counter Assembly (86100C Option 001 only) is susceptible to electrical overstress through the DCA's front panel Trigger port. Adding the diode limiter to the input of the counter assembly will improve the reliability of the DCA.

We are recommending that the diode limiter be added only in the situation where the counter assembly has been damaged through electrical overstress. DCAs built after June 1, 2006 has the diode limiter installed at the factory.

Solution/Action:

During the A14 Counter Assembly replacement process, a new cable and limiter are installed.

Refer to the procedures in the 86100C Infiniium DCA Service Guide under "To Remove the A13 Acquisition and 86100C A14 Counter Assembly (Option 001)".

Procedure:

1. Once the A13 Acquisition Assembly and the A14 Counter Assembly are removed from the DCA chassis, position them as shown in the figures below. Remove the existing cable W31, part number 86100-20053, from the A14J2 INPUT and discard.




Figure 1, A14 Counter board Mounted on the A13 Acquisition Assembly




Figure 2, Cables W32 and W31 (circled)

2. Connect the new W31, part number 86100-20082, to A14J2 INPUT. The W32 cable remains connected to the A14J3 OUTPUT.

- 3. Install the A13 Acquisition Assembly and the A14 Counter Assembly into the DCA chassis.




Figure 3, A15 Diode Limiter and SW2 Cable Connections

- 4. Connect cable W32 (from A14J3) to SW2P1 as shown in Figure 3 below. Torque the 5/16" connector to 8 in-lbs.

- 5. Connect the A15 Diode Limiter to SW2P4 as shown in Figure 3 above. Torque the connector to 8 in-lbs using a 5/16" torque wrench.
- 6. Locate W31 from A14J2 and connect it to the A15 diode limiter.

NOTE: When connected, do not allow W32 and W32 to touch the A13 Acquisition Assembly

- 7. Reinstall the instrument cover, calibration access plug, rear-panel feet, and side handles.
- 8. Turn on the instrument, and allow it to warm up for 1 hour.
- 9. Perform the timebase adjustment using the equipment and procedures outlined in the 86100A/B/C Service Guide.
- 10. Be sure to perform verification procedures, including the Option 001 tests, which required the VISION test software and equipment. These tests cannot be done manually.
- 11. This completes the retrofit of the diode limiter.
