Situation:

Some customers may have seen an intermittent failure with the 9000A series front panel channel 2 position knobs not working. This can usually be cured temporary by cycling the Infiniium application off then back on. This will work most of the time, but then later the knob may stop working again.

Solution/Action:

Replace the Front Panel keyboard Assembly

Re-program the new Front FPGA and PIC.

Once the new front panel is installed then it will be necessary to make sure the Front Panel FPGA and PIC is programmed to the correct version needed to support the Infiniium application.

1. Using a command prompt type regedit. This will bring up the registry editor and then navigate to the same as the below picture.

- 2. Right click on the FrontPanelFpgaVersion and Delete.
- 3. Right click on the FrontPanelPicVersion and Delete.
- 4. Exit out of regedit.
- 5. Once this is done using the control panel Add/Remove programs remove the Infiniium application, Infiniium Demos, Infiniium Manuals and Reboot.
- 6. Then install the Infiniium application you wanted.
