The Anthro Arm pole is designed to rotate thus the operator of the machine can move the keyboard and monitor to a suitable position . This also enables it to be retracted from the front area of the hood/door of the AOI machine.

The Monitor power cable exits the pole at the top through a slot cut into the side of the pole. If this cable is wrapped around the pole a few times then there is possibility of damaging the cable insulation and exposing a live conductor which would present a potential shock hazard.

### Solution/Action:

Please take immediate action to fix or prevent this potential shock hazard by ordering AA safety kit 5186-5490 and follow the installation instructions 5186-5489.
