Situation:

U3800A with FW version 1.7.2 will produce an error message "pip: command not found", when trying to execute "pip" command in Python.

Example: "pip -V", "pip install bluepy"

A screenshot of the issue:

Poky (Yocto Project Reference Distro) 1.7.2 edison ttyMFD2
edison login: root
root@edison:~# pip -V

Solution/Action:

Upgrade the FW to version 1.7.3 or later. This update can be performed by the user:

1. Check U3800A firmware version

Connect to the U3800A with PuTTY. The firmware version is displayed with the login prompt. If the installed version is 1.7.2, proceed to step 2 to update the firmware. Otherwise, your U3800A is in good condition and no further action is required.



- 2. Re-flash U3800 FW version
 - Refer to Flash Intel Edison Firmware" in the Getting Started Guide starting on page 23. Follow the instructions precisely. Note: user files that previously saved in U3800A will be deleted.
- 3. Restore Auto Boot Up Display
 Refer to "Auto Boot Up Display Setup" in the Getting Started Guide (pages 28 to 29) to restore
 the LCD display.
